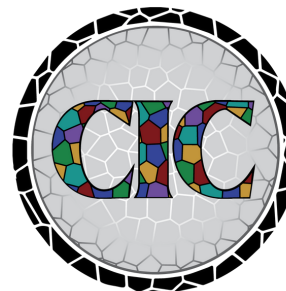

- Screening call with Program Director
- Make an AmeriCorps Profile in My.AmeriCorps
- Submit Profile to CIC
- Interview with site(s) of interest
- Mutual agreement with member/site
- Offer from program and complete My.AmeriCorps application
- Federal background checks

Member Eligibility

- US or Naturalized Citizen
- At least 18 years of age
- Able to pass a federal criminal background check
