The Interfaith Enrichment Corps is an AmeriCorps program. Members commit their time to address critical community needs.

IEC began 11 years ago as the Immigrant and Refugee Service Corps.

IEC service terms are September - August (full-term) and February - August (half-term)

IEC is an AmeriCorps program administered by the Center for Interfaith Cooperation, as a Sub-Grantee of Serve Indiana (a State Grantee of AmeriCorps). This program is available to all, without regard to race, color, national origin, disability, age, sex, political affiliations, or, in most cases, religion.
